This Mentorship, based at Beaudesert Library, aims to provide an Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander young person (16-25 years) with learning and development opportunities in a supportive workplace environment.

Council, in partnership with the State Library of Queensland and with the support of the local Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander community, is looking for a person for a temporary period of approximately 12-16 weeks to:

- Gain experience in a public library environment
- Experience the breadth of activities carried out; and
- Assist in developing a program for young people (based on your special interests or a newly learned skill)
- Create an environment where you are encouraged to discover and develop your potential
- Increase your likelihood of obtaining employment in the community and/or wider industry
- Provide networking opportunities between yourself and other public library staff
- Encourage working relationships between local Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander organisations, individuals and the library
